

Internet Explorer 11 - Setting a Website to Display in Compatibility View

An Internet Explorer 11 update has caused problems with websites and services like the FAA National Wildlife Strike Database and Reporting system. This issue may be resolved by adding the affected websites to the compatibility mode list.

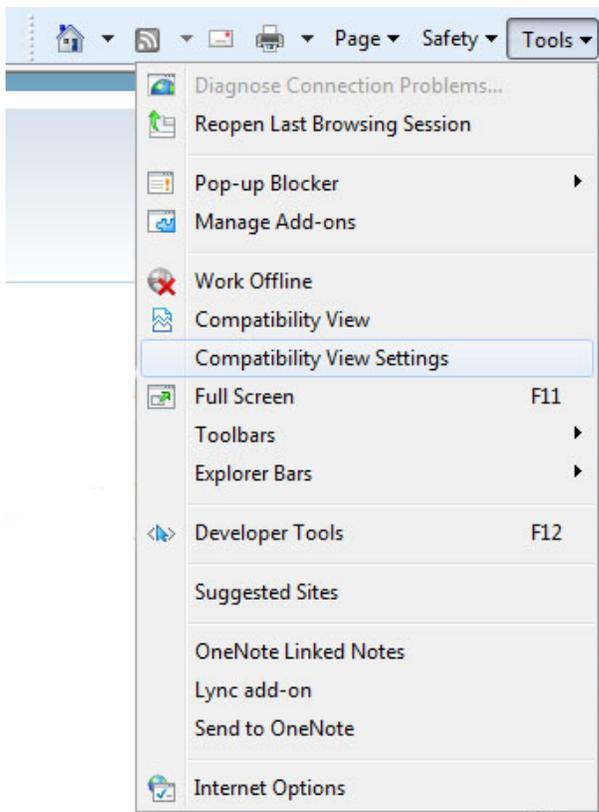
These websites can be added to the compatibility mode list by doing the following:

1. In Internet Explorer, click on the **Tools** menu. Unless you have the menu bar enabled, this will be a gear icon: 
 - o **Note:** You can display the menu bar by either: 1) pressing the ALT key or 2) right-clicking the Address bar and selecting **Menu bar**.
2. Click **Compatibility View Settings**.

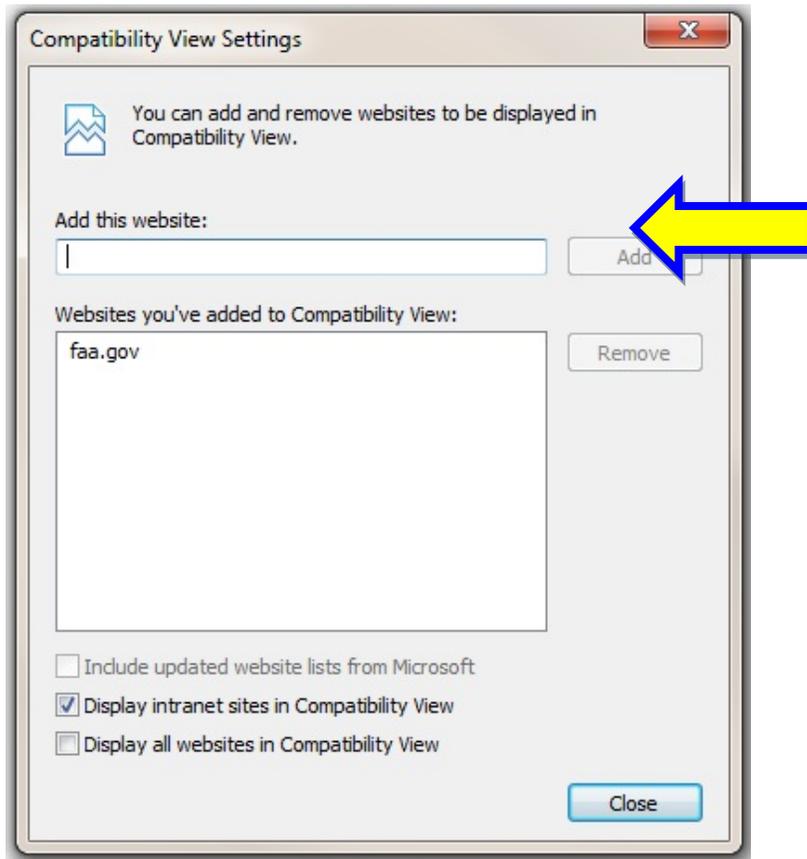

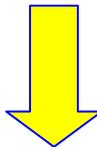


3. Under **Add this website**, enter the URL of the site you want to add.
 - o should be entered as “faa.gov”



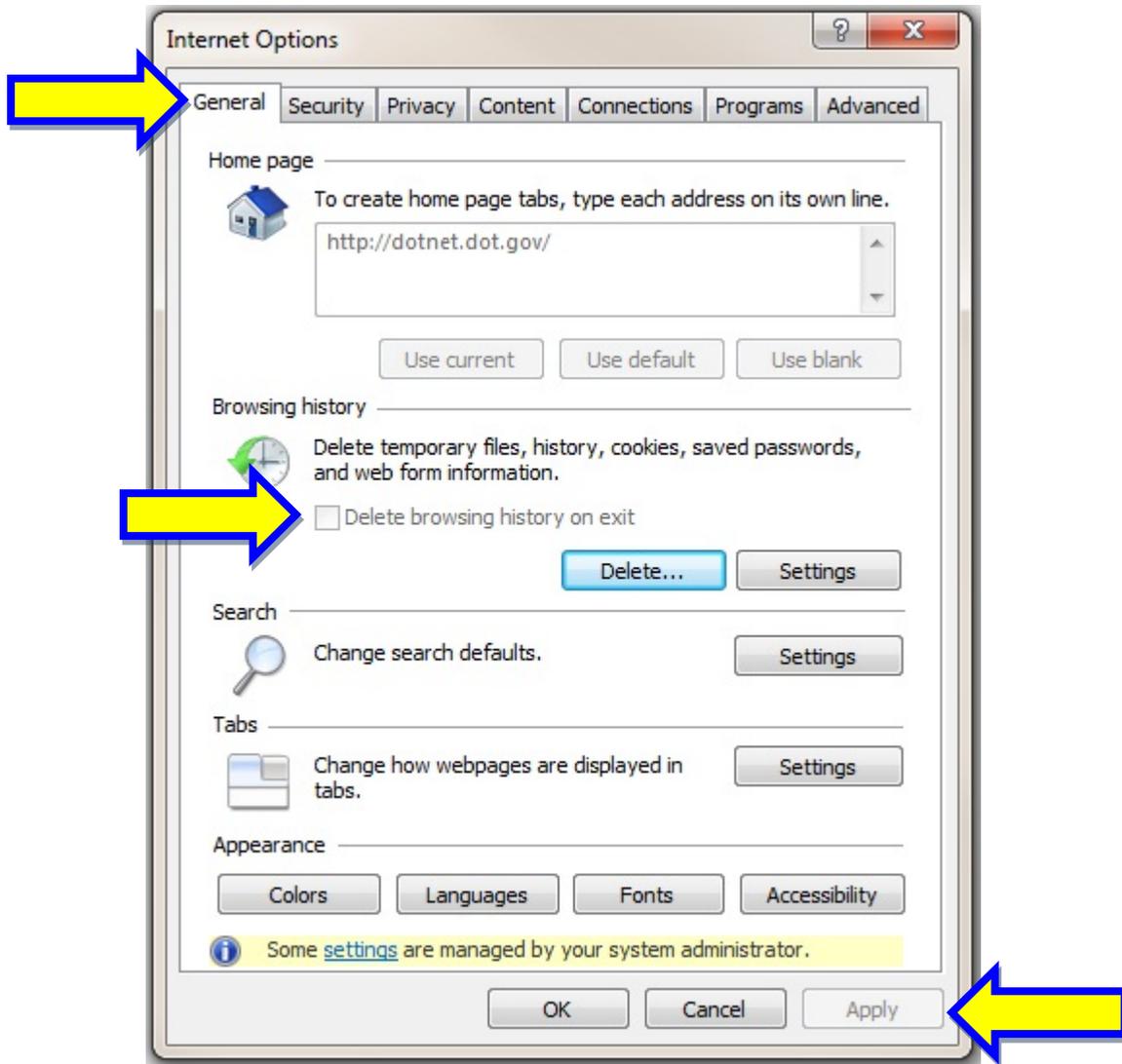
4. Click **Add**.
5. Upon reloading the webpage, content should display properly.

One more option for changing a default setting on following page.



Note: By default, IE11 is set to clear your browser history when you quit, which also clears the list of websites added to Compatibility View. To disable this setting:

1. Open the **Tools** menu as described in step 1 above, then select **Internet Options**.
2. Under the **General** tab, uncheck the **Delete browser history on exit**, then click **Apply**. If you do not disable this setting, you will need to recreate this list every time you launch IE.
